Healthy Students, Promising Futures Survey

From HSPF: "We know how important school Medicaid is in providing sustainable funding for school health services. Now, more than ever, it is important to be able to demonstrate the value of school Medicaid—and what's at risk if school Medicaid funding is cut.

To assess the potential impact of cuts on school health services, resources and funding, Healthy Schools Campaign, in partnership with AASA, the Association of School Business Officials International (ASBO), National Alliance for Medicaid in Education (NAME) and Council for Advancement and Support of Education (CASE), is distributing an online survey. This survey is designed for school district leaders, administrators and district-level staff, including business and finance officials.

We're aiming to gather at least 1,000 responses. If you can participate, please take a few minutes to complete this survey or forward it to other school district partners or colleagues. We would love to hear your feedback!

Survey data will be compiled in the aggregate, and results will be shared to inform federal and state policymakers about the school Medicaid program and the impact of proposed federal cuts. Individual responses are voluntary, and respondents will be kept anonymous.
