Physical Therapy Evaluation Coding Notes (Adapted from the 2022 AMA CPT® Manual)

- Physical therapy evaluations include an:
 - History
 - Examination
 - o Clinical decision making
 - o Development of plan of care
- All of the above components should be documented so that the appropriate PT evaluation code can be chosen
