### Complete the Fall 2025 NH MTS Needs Assessment Survey

The New Hampshire Medicaid to Schools Program is undergoing a significant transition from In-Kind Reimbursement to Certified Public Expenditure by July 1, 2026. Your feedback is crucial to inform program improvements, identify key needs, and shape the future of the NH MTS Program as it undergoes this transition.

# <u>Federally Required Annual Certification of Local Match for</u> <u>Medicaid Reimbursement Statement</u>

Federal regulations allow states to use state general funds or other non-federal governmental funding sources to be used as "state match". To prove that this match is being made, each SAU must document that the SAU has provided at least 50% of the cost of services reimbursed by Medicaid, as required under He-W 589.08. The linked form "Documentation of Expenditure of Non-Federal Funds" is to be used to comply with federal documentation requirements. The Match for Medicaid funds form is due October 31st.

### 2025 Occupational Therapy Waiver Template

Check your waivers! Districts may have Occupational Therapy (OT) waivers expiring by the end of October 2025. Some OT waivers are approved for only one year. 




